

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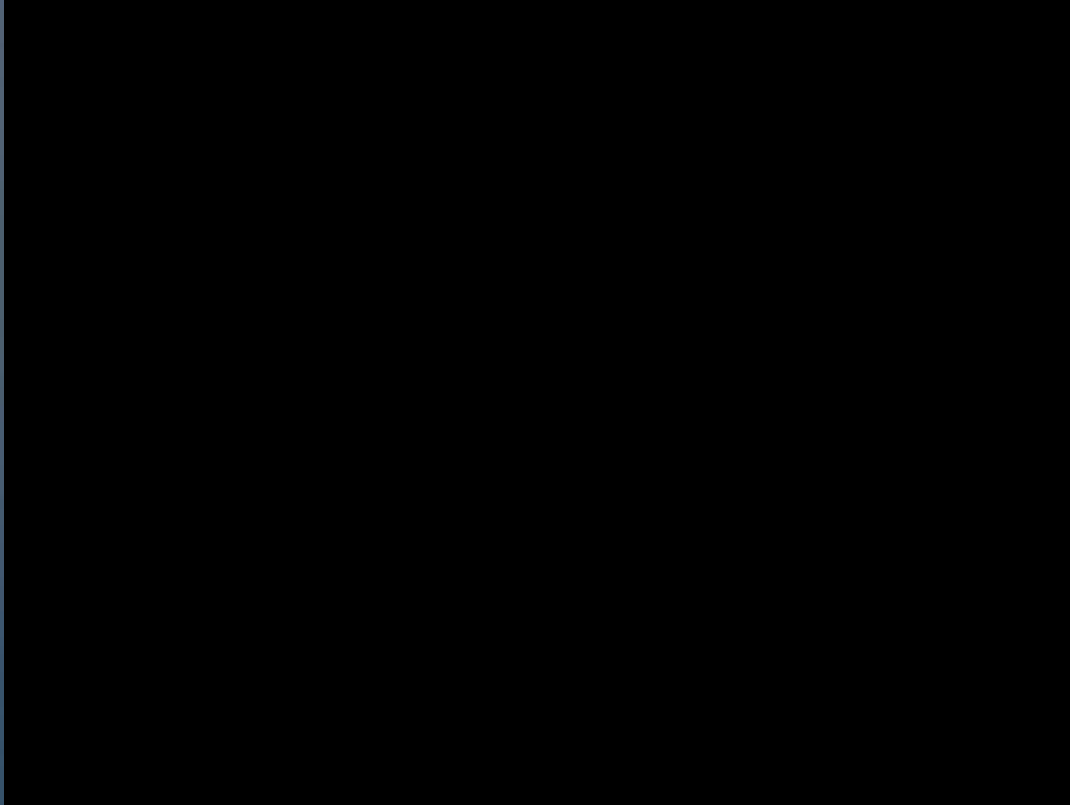


Goals and Mission

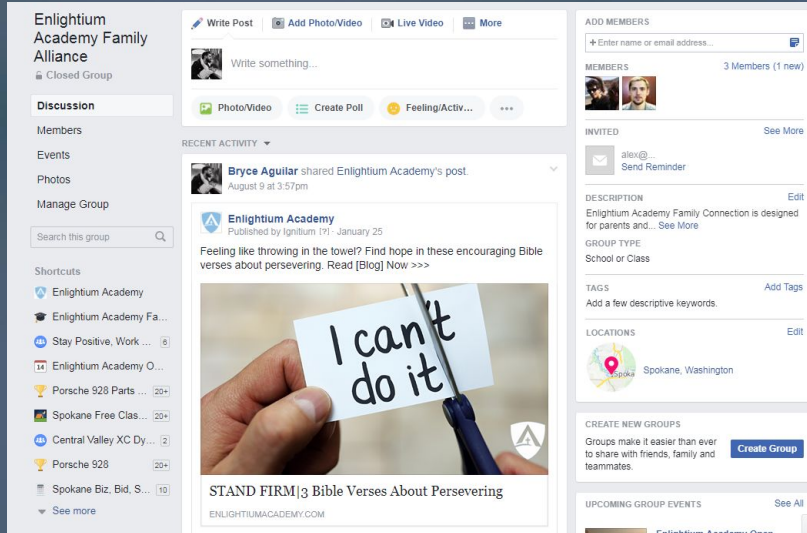

Student Orientation

- Bookmark the login page for the curriculum so that you can continue to work even if EA's main website is down.

This second bullet-point is extremely important. If EA's website goes down for a few hours, you will not be able to work and will fall behind in your coursework. This can cause significant stress. However, if you follow the instructions in this video and bookmark the EA login page, you will be able to bypass the main website and work without delay even when the website is unavailable.



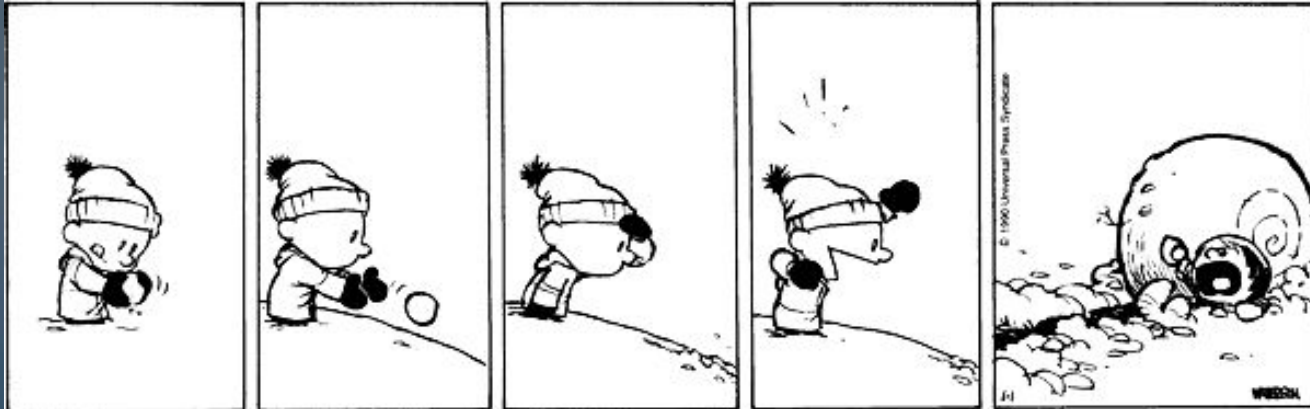
