2. Warm up for each letter and check position.
3. Trace and copy the letters while the teacher observes the position, formation and spacing. Complete the line and the line below each of the letters and words.
4. During the week read the story of Noah and discuss God's covenant (promise).
5. Introduce words that may be unfamiliar, such as "covenant."
6. Additional blank lines may be used for practice, for original sentences, for class sentences, for phrases, for rhyming words and so on.
7. The additional blank lines may be used for writing practice of the student(s) last name.

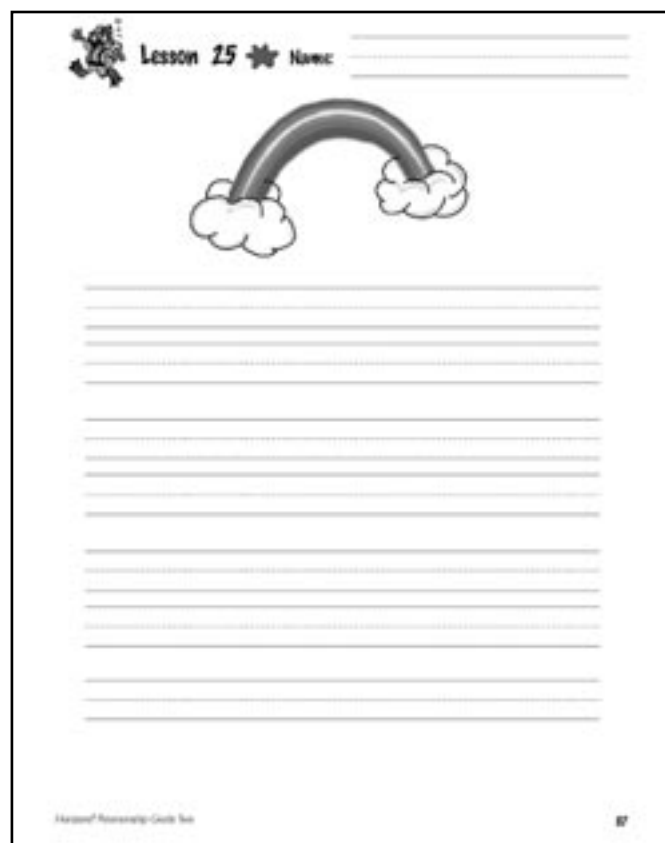
