CURRICULUM

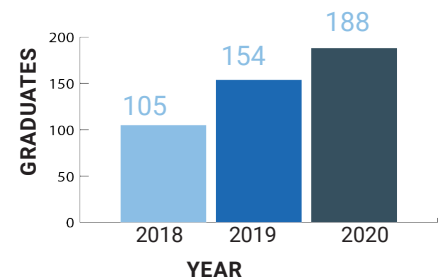
