If you are enrolling before September 18, 2023, you can register for a social activity during Student Social Week.

- <u>Bible Studies</u> (most relaxing) join other students and an Enlightium teacher in Bible Studies twice a month
- <u>Book Clubs</u> (most critical thinking) select from a list of books and join a group to discuss themes and more
- <u>Chess Club</u> (most analytical thinking) join students to compete in tournaments and sharpen playing skills
- Equestrian Club (most enjoyable for animal lovers) students learn and discuss horses and how to care for them
