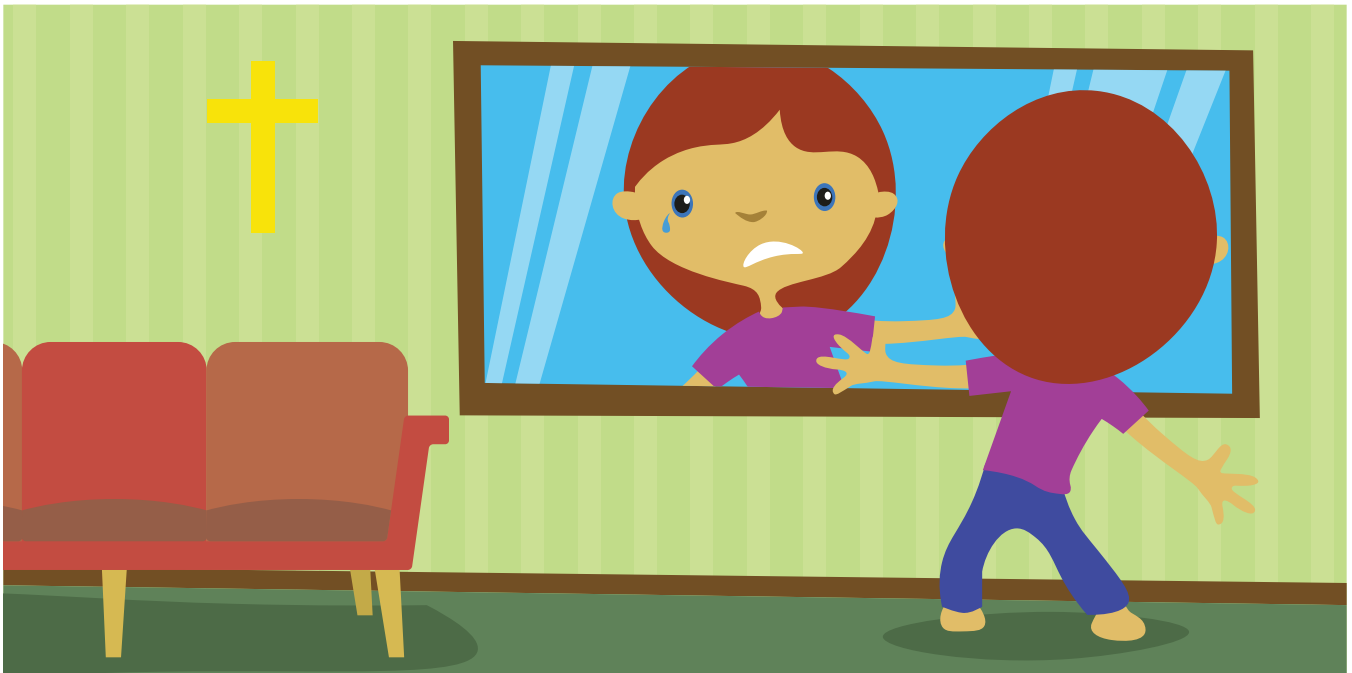
I Can Believe in Jesus

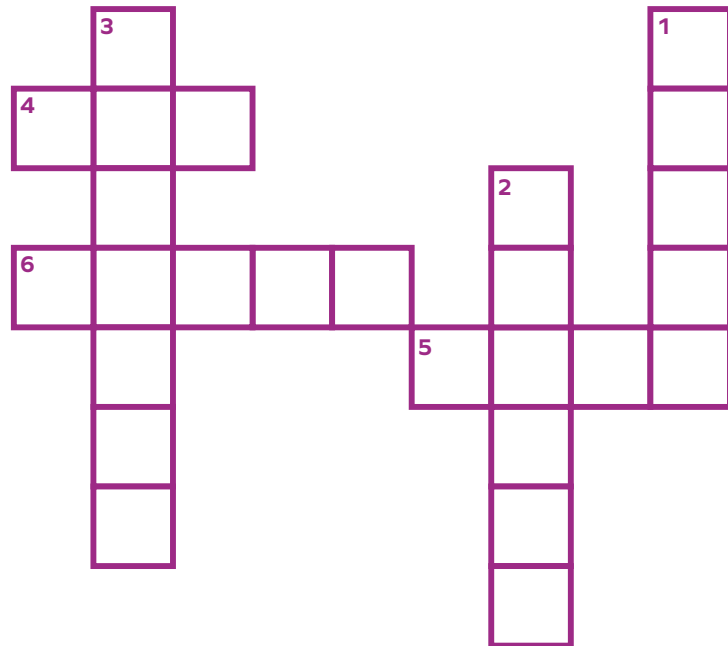

Sometimes I feel sad. Sometimes I am angry. Sometimes I am tired. Sometimes I don't understand things.

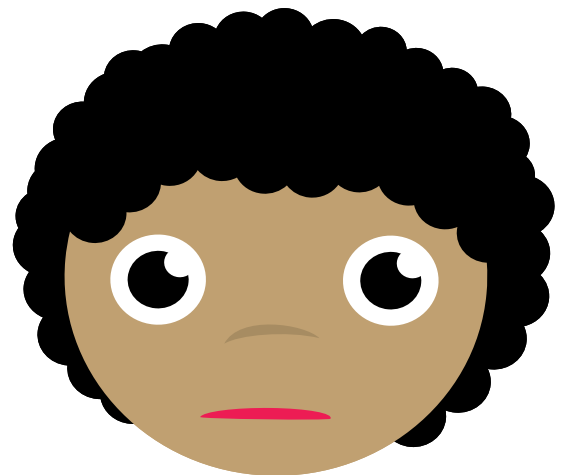
God helps me in these times.

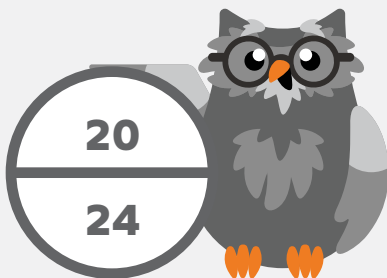

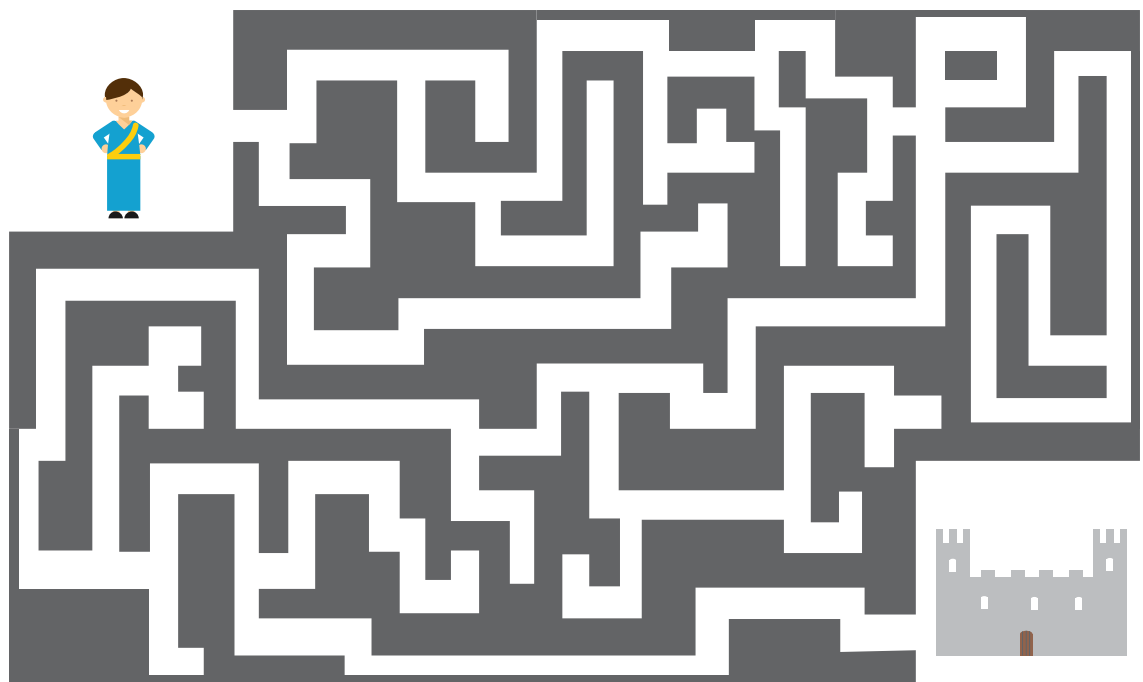

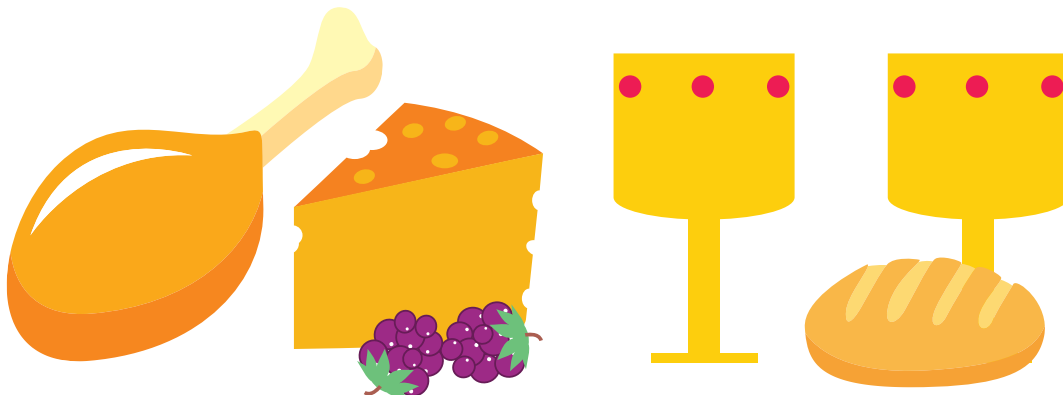

Daniel Obeyed God

The palace was very big. Daniel missed his family. Daniel was *not* lonely, because Daniel talked to God every day. Daniel wanted to live God's way. God had a special plan for Daniel's life. Daniel trusted God.

The king wanted the Israelite boys to eat his rich food. God's Word said not to eat this kind of food. Daniel wanted to obey God's Word. He did not want to eat the king's food.



| The Israelite boys did not want to eat the king's rich food.

Daniel and three friends said, “No, we would like to have water and **vegetables**, please.”

For ten days, the four boys ate vegetables and drank water. All the other boys ate the king’s food. After ten days, Daniel and his three friends looked very strong. The boys eating the king’s food were not as strong.

King Nebuchadnezzar had a bad dream. He could not remember the dream. He was afraid. He wanted to know about the dream.

All of the king's wise men could not help him. They could not tell the king about his dream. The king was very angry. He was going to kill all the wise men.

Daniel did not want the men to be killed. Daniel asked God to tell him the meaning of the king's dream.

That night, God told Daniel about the king's dream. Only God could know about the dream.

Daniel was so happy. The Bible tells us that Daniel answered and said, "... Blessed (wonderful) be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom (to know everything) and might (to be strong) are his." (Daniel 2:20)

The next day, Daniel told the king what God had said about the dream. The king was so thankful he fell down at Daniel's feet. King Nebuchadnezzar said, "Your God is the only true God."

The king gave Daniel many great gifts. The king made Daniel a great ruler over all the wise men.

God Protected Daniel

God had blessed Daniel so much. Some people did not like Daniel because he had so many blessings.

A new king named Darius (Dar i us) made Daniel a great ruler. He made Daniel a ruler over all the people. Some leaders wanted to have Daniel killed. The leaders tricked the king into making a new law. The law said that everyone must pray only to the king for the next 30 days. If they prayed to anyone else, they would be put into the lions' den.

Daniel knew about the law. But Daniel would pray only to God as he always had. To know that God will **protect** you is to have **faith**. Daniel had faith.

The leaders told King Darius about Daniel praying to God. King Darius was sorry he had made this law. The king did not want Daniel killed. The leaders said that Daniel must be put into the lions' den.

Daniel was put into the den of hungry lions. King Darius was so sad that he could not sleep.

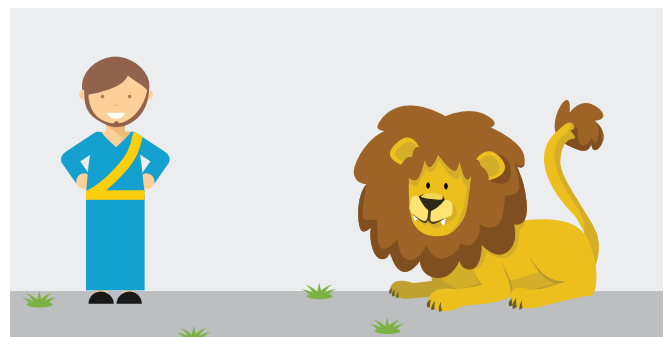
