Printable Checklist

All steps should be completed before Monday, April 19, 2021.

Step 1. Run a Successful Systems Check*

The system check tests your device to make sure it meets the minimum requirements for test delivery.



Step 2. Download and launch the Pearson Browser*

This browser locks down the computer's operating system and does not allow the student to access anything else until the Pearson browser is closed.



Step 3. Ensure an Adult Proctor will be Present For Both Days

Testing days are Thursday, April 22 and Friday, April 23. The Adult Proctor will need to be present both days.



Step 4. Write down the testing hours

Session A: 6 - 10 am PT for both days.

Session B: 10 am - 2 pm PT for both days.

Session B: 2 - 6 pm PT for both days.



Step 5. Have materials ready

Students can have a pencil and paper available for some tests. Students may be able to use a calculator as noted when taking the assessment; students can NOT use a smartphone, tablet, or other Internet-connected device as a calculator.



Step 6. Choose a quiet location for testing*

Find a location at home away from noise and distraction where your student can test. Families with multiple students testing should choose different testing sessions and/or test in different parts of a room to reduce noise.

Final Tips for Testers

- If you are unable to run the Pearson browser, right click on the app and select "run as administrator".
- Consider having a backup phone and/or computer on testing days with the systems check complete and Pearson browser previously installed.
- If you cannot find the Pearson browser, use the search feature on your computer and type in "Pearson".
- Write down the phone number of the conference and meeting number along with the testing session ID that will be emailed 15 minutes before the test starts in case you get disconnected.
