## Using the Test Packet for *A SERVANT'S HEART*

Teaching Bible should not be a mere presentation of facts but a vehicle to reach the hearts and lives of your students with God's Word. The emphasis of the curriculum is on guiding students to an understanding of their salvation need, and on leading them toward Christlikeness—knowing Christ and having a daily, personal relationship with Him.

These tests provide the teacher with objective items that can serve as part of student evaluation. However, the tests cannot substitute for informal, individual assessment of a student's understanding and application: how much interest he shows in Bible, how well he learns Bible verses, and how well he applies Bible knowledge to everyday life.

Bible is not a subject that must be graded; the unit tests are optional. Assigning letter grades to these tests often will require the teacher to deviate from a strict percentage for the number of correct answers out of the number of questions. Some of the tests have as few as 10 questions. For these tests it seems reasonable to give a letter grade of C if a student gets 5 or 6 correct answers, a grade of B for 7 or 8 correct answers, and an A for 9 or 10 correct answers. Using the same idea for tests that have more than 10 possible answers seems reasonable, with the objective of encouraging student success. Adjust the tests in accordance with your teaching emphasis and direction by eliminating some items and/or providing additional test items.
