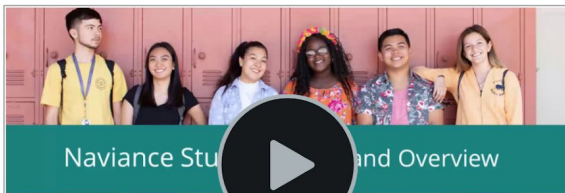

- Not rushing & taking advantage of the 2nd attempts!
- Maintaining good grades
- Not falling 2 or more weeks behind
- Make sure your student is reviewing answers to previous assignments, and asking for help as questions come up and when the solutions in previous assignments are not understood.
- Ensure the student takes notes, and utilizes available resources ([LiveBinder](#), [tutoring](#)).

The *then* clause in a conditional statement.

conditional or implication

Two statements connected by the form If ..., then....

conjunction

A statement formed by combining two statements with the word *and*.

contrapositive of a conditional

A statement formed by interchanging the hypothesis and the conclusion in a conditional statement, and negating both.

converse of a conditional

A statement formed by interchanging the hypothesis and the conclusion in a conditional statement.

deductive reasoning

Reasoning that leads from statement of a general fact to a specific conclusion

disjunction

A statement formed by combining two statements with the word *or*.

hypothesis

The *if* clause in a conditional statement.

inductive reasoning

The process of making a general conclusion based on specific examples.

inverse of a conditional

A statement formed by negating both the hypothesis and the conclusion in a conditional statement.

negation

If p is a statement, the new statement, not p or $\neg p$ is false is the negation of p .

statement

A theoretical declaration made in speech or writing; used to prove logical reasoning.

true-false statement

A sentence that is true or false, but not both.

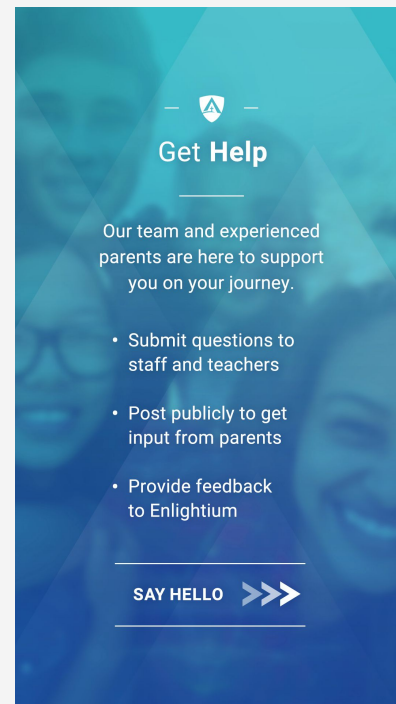
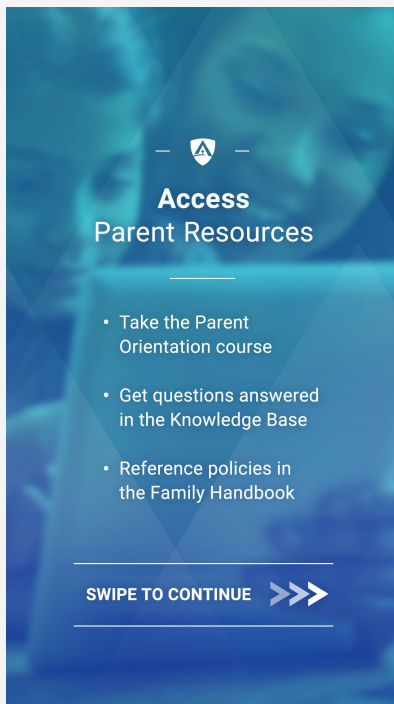
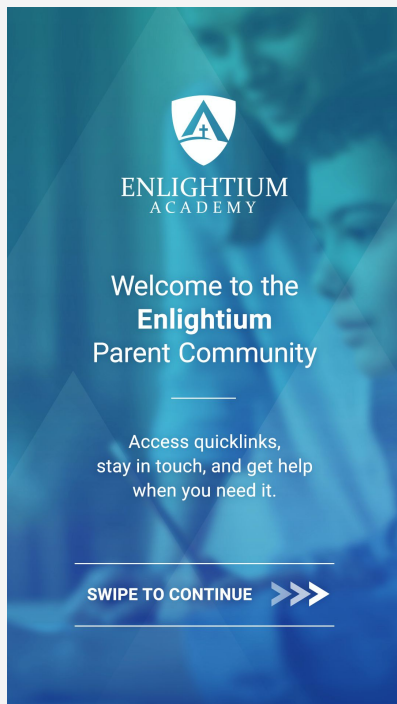

College Credit

Earn 3 college credits with each concurrent credit course taken through Enlightenment Academy. NNU credits are transferable to most colleges and universities across the country.

Credit hours taken at one college or university can transfer to another and be applied toward degree requirements. Once a student successfully completes a concurrent credit course, he or she has earned course credit from NNU that may be used at NNU or transferred to another institution upon high school graduation.

COST:

Concurrent credit courses are about 10% of the average total cost of college credit. The concurrent courses offered are 3 credits per high school NNU course. The additional cost of the course is as follows:

Tuition discounts do not apply to the additional cost for the concurrent course. Additional payment (if applicable) is due within 30 days of enrollment. The Accounting Department will reach out via email to arrange a payment. No refunds will be made from NNU after November 15.

Dual Enrollment Credit Courses



- DE College Level Courses available for 11-12th Grade
- Attend a college of your choice and we can transfer any course the college approves to be transferred to a high school requirement.

College Credit

At the discretion of the college admissions team, credit hours taken at one college or university may be transferred to another school and be applied toward degree requirements.

Upon successful completion of a dual enrolled credit course, you have earned course credit. The credit may be used for continued college enrollment or transferred to another institution upon high school graduation.

REGISTRATION:

Register for Dual Enrollment at Enlightium Academy. Enroll in a maximum of three college credits per term while also earning a minimum of one Enlightium Academy high school credit per year.
