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# To the Teacher

## Using the Tests

Teaching the Bible is an exciting opportunity. Much more than just an avenue for presenting biblical data, it is a purposeful vehicle for reaching the hearts and minds of your students with God's wisdom from His Word. The emphasis of the curriculum is on guiding students to understand their need to be saved from sin and on leading them toward Christlikeness—knowing Christ and having a daily personal relationship with Him.

These tests provide the teacher with objective items that can serve as part of student evaluation. However, the tests cannot substitute for informal, individual assessment of a student's understanding and application. Such things as how much interest he shows in the Bible, how well he learns and understands Bible verses, and how purposefully he applies Bible knowledge to everyday life can provide a much better indication of what is really taking place inside him.

The most effective tests are an outgrowth of the teaching process. Accordingly, these tests can be adapted to meet the teaching emphasis and direction as well as the student's maturation level. The teacher may find it necessary to eliminate some items or provide additional test items.

The tests in this packet vary throughout in both style and number of questions. The appropriateness and grading of these tests will depend on your purpose and philosophy. You may adjust point values in each section of the test to reflect your teaching methodology, the extent of presentation, and your balance of facts and concepts.
