

Bronze Program Parent Agreement (Grades 3-10)

The Bronze Program is designed for students in grades 3-10 whose parents are equipped and ready to take the initiative of educating their own students using our accredited online curriculum while being under the umbrella and guidance of the accredited institution. Parents provide supervision and academic support for their student's learning in home settings. Enlightium Academy provides assignment grading and record-keeping, as well as report cards for students in grades 3-8 and transcripts for students in grades 9-10.

Parent's Responsibilities

- I understand that I am the sole academic support for my student.
- I understand that there is **no Enlightium teacher support** in the Bronze Program besides grading.
- I understand that my student needs to keep their grades above 73% to stay in the Bronze Program.
- I will explain any new concept to my student and answer all of my student's questions.

- I will supervise my student and keep my student on track to finish the school year by the predetermined end date.
- I will review my student's quizzes and tests, and I will explain all missed concepts.
- I will <u>log into my Parental Portal</u> or <u>use the Student Portal</u>, on a weekly basis to check on the student's grades and progress.

- I understand that counselor support is available through email, but not by phone or screensharing.
- I will check my personal email weekly for important messages from Enlightium.
- I will check the Enlightium Parents app at least once a week for important messages from Enlightium.
- I will notify Enlightium concerning planned absences by submitting the <u>Absence Form</u>.
- I will remain aware of my <u>state's</u> <u>homeschooling requirements</u>.
- I understand that there is no Tier 3 academic intervention or any other kind of intervention in the Bronze Program.
- I understand that some Enlightium offerings are unavailable to Bronze students, including our honors program.
- I understand that there are no 504 or IEP accommodations in the Bronze program.
- I understand that if my student is failing several courses or is truant, the school reserves the right to upgrade the student to the Silver program without warning.

Enlightium's Academic Policy

The student must maintain a grade point average (GPA) for all subjects of 2.0 or above. If a student has grades below 73% in one or more subjects, they will be required to upgrade to a program with support from Enlightium teachers. In that case, the tuition will be adjusted accordingly, or the student will be withdrawn from Enlightium. Returning students who had grades below 73% in any course and/or incomplete schoolwork will not be allowed to enroll in the Bronze program.
